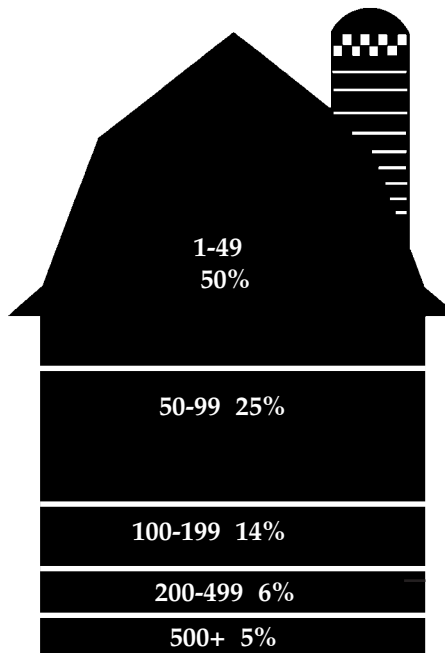

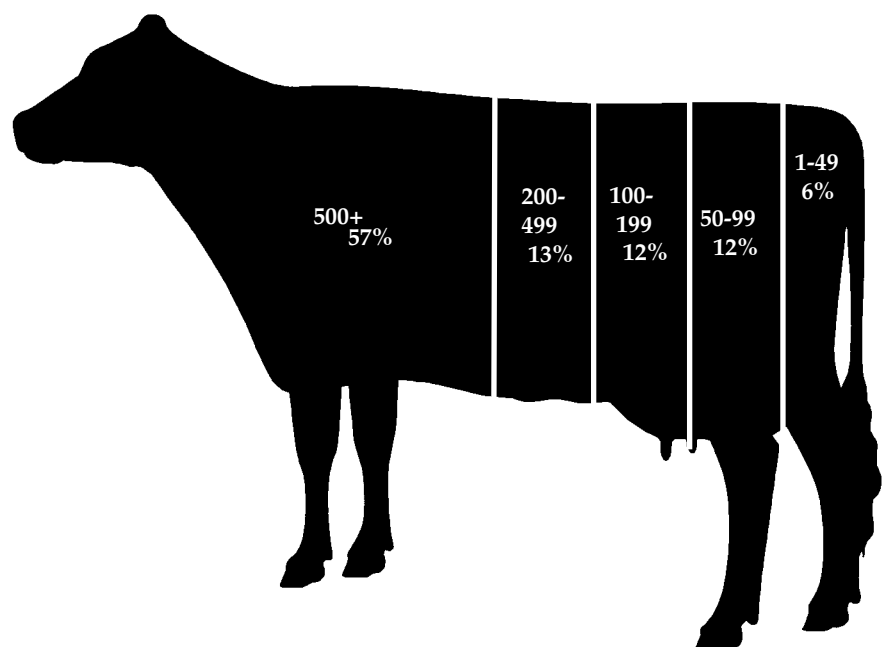


DAIRY CATTLE DISPOSITION 2011
